- Condition: .1: slightly worn; slight tears at bottom right and upper left; pieces of paper from scrapbook still attached to back
  - .2: slightly worn; upper left corner missing and cracked; lower right corner cracked; tear at top center; scrapbook paper on back; image is very blurry in center
  - .3: slightly worn; large tear and stain at lower right corner; scrapbook paper on back
  - .4: slightly worn and stained; upper right and lower left corners are cracked; scrapbook paper on back
  - .5: slightly worn and stained; upper and lower right corners are cracked; scrapbook paper on back
  - .6: slightly worn; scrapbook paper on back
  - .7: upper left, upper and lower right corners are cracked; slightly stained on back

Description: The donor noted that some of the photos show the class of 1930 at Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania and that Dean Tracy (Martha) "took us to luncheon."

Additional Comments: These photographs were found in a file cabinet containing items from the office of a previous director of the Archives. An acknowledgment letter and Deed of Gift had been sent, the Deed of Gift signed and returned, and an accession number assigned, but there was No accession record or finding aids created for these items. And so, this accession record has been created in October of 1997, even though the gift was donated in 1995.
